Programming Resources:

MMLA plans to use the 98c Learning Loss Grant to address learning loss by :

1. Utilizing the GrapeSeed program for our ELL students and K-jr. -1st grade. This program focuses on improving sounds through phonemic awareness, letter recognition, and selecting students for small group reading 3 times per week
2. MTSS Coordinators for math and reading will provide best practices and data digs for teachers to have NWEA test results for (Math and Reading) to support the teachers in providing effective instructions.
3. Technology Program: TYTO program for middle school students 6-8th grade. Having students work with math/reading programs through technology. Teachers receive immediate results.
4. Update the Tracking form program through SWISS to focus on attendance, behaviors, and academics. Focus on enhancing the whole child.
5. Panorama: an MTSS progress monitoring and management system for all grades K Jr -8 and all school staff with an account. This program works with SWIS, PowerSchool, and NWEA. This program addresses the whole child by even incorporating our Second Step Program whis is for our Social Emotional program.

Implementation Timeline:

The GrapeSeed program is already being implemented Jr. K-1 and MTSS Coordinators will start their support as soon as November 2022.

Metrics Used to Evaluate the Program:

We will continue to use our NWEA testing data as well as our progress monitoring through the MTSS program.
